NEERO 2021 Virtual Annual Meeting

April 28 - 30, 2021

NEERO will host the NEERO 2021 Annual Meeting* as a virtual conference from April 28 -30, 2021.

After reviewing the results from the recent survey to the NEERO community, which demonstrated substantial interest in a virtual conference and barriers to in-person attendance, we have decided host the conference as an entirely virtual event.

The NEERO 2021 Call for Submissions will be shared on September 1, 2020. Proposals will be due November 2, 2020. Stay tuned!

* Authors of accepted NEERO 2020 presentations are invited to present their research in the same format at the NEERO 2021 virtual conference.


NEERO Elections: Electronic Vote Coming Soon!
